

Dress code requirements are in effect from a student's arrival until the end of the school day. Only items specified in this document are considered approved classroom attire. Please refer to the Lands' End item numbers when purchasing.

All items listed with a Lands' End item number reference <u>must</u> be purchased from Lands' End. Items with no specifications may be purchased from any store.

UNIFORM FOR BOYS

EVERYDAY ATTIRE FOR BOYS:

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SHIRTS

Lands' End Polo with School Logo

- Colors: classic navy*, white, or gray heather
 - Short or long sleeve
 - Refer to Lands' End item numbers
- A solid white long sleeve t-shirt or turtleneck may be worn under short sleeve uniform polos.

*Every student must have a navy polo for when Casual Enrichment Attire is required. All shirttails must be long enough to remain tucked in when reaching up or bending over. No tight or undersized shirts. No oversized shirts.

PANTS AND SHORTS

Classic or Traditional Style Pants and/or Shorts

Colors: navy or khaki

As long as guidelines are followed, uniform style pants and shorts may be purchased from any vendor/store. No low-rise pants. Must have belt loops for the required belt. (Grades K-2 only may have an elastic waist with no belt loops and no belt.) Not permitted: spandex, denim, corduroy, decorations, cargo pants, extra pockets, zip-off knees, or zip pockets.

BELT

• Solid Color Leather or Stretch Belt

• Colors: navy, white, gray, brown, or black Belts must not have excessive metal.

SHOES

- Tennis/Athletic (any color)
- Docksiders
- Oxfords (tie type)
- Loafers
- Not Permitted: boots, booties, clogs, sandals, backless shoes, or heels higher than one inch

SOCKS

Solid Color Socks

- Colors: navy, white, gray, or black
- Small logos acceptable
- Must not exceed knee length

Socks must be worn.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- P.E. Shirts and Shorts
 - Purchased from the <u>school webstore</u>
 - Grade 3: P.E. clothes will be worn to school on P.E. day.
 - Grades 4-8: P.E. clothes must be worn in P.E. class only.
- Sweatpants (optional)
 - Colors: navy or gray (no writing, stripes, or designs except school logo)
 - May be worn during cold weather
 - Must be classic "baggy, loose-fitting" style (no athletic
 - pants/yoga pants/leggings, not tight, not low-riding)
 - Compression Tights (optional)
 - Colors: navy, white, gray, or black
 - May be worn under P.E. uniform

SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS PERMITTED IN CLASS

- SOLID NAVY Perimeter Sweatshirt
 - All past and present navy sweatshirts purchased from the <u>school</u> webstore
 - SOLID NAVY Perimeter Sweatshirt with Athletics Eagle Logo

 Purchased from the <u>school webstore</u>
- Lands' End Navy Fleece Jacket with School Logo

<u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>

Other coats and jackets may <u>only</u> be worn outside. **Pullover sweatshirts (that are not approved Perimeter sweatshirts) may** <u>not</u> be worn anywhere on **campus during the school day, including carline, recess, etc.**

CASUAL ENRICHMENT ATTIRE (SERVICE PROJECTS) FOR BOYS:

Lands' End Navy Polo with School Logo

- Short or long sleeve
- <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
- Khaki Pants or Shorts
 - Jeans may only be worn if specified by the lead service project parent for outside or messy work.
 - Casual Shoes (including tennis/athletic shoes)
 - Boots may only be worn if specified by the lead service project parent for outside or messy work.

Students may wear sweatshirts/jackets permitted in class along with other coats and jackets. Pullover sweatshirts (that are not approved Perimeter sweatshirts) may <u>not</u> be worn on Perimeter School service projects, field trips, etc.

DRESSY ENRICHMENT ATTIRE FOR BOYS:

- Navy Blazer
- White Oxford Shirt
 - $\circ \qquad \text{Short or long sleeve}$
- Official School Tie/Bowtie
 - Purchased from the <u>school webstore</u>
- Khaki Pants
- Leather Belt
 - Color: brown or black
- Dress Shoes
 - $\circ \qquad {\rm Color:} \ {\rm brown} \ {\rm or} \ {\rm black}$
 - Docksiders
 - Oxfords (tie type)
 - Loafers
 - No athletic shoes, slip-on sneakers, or boots of any kind
- Solid Navy Mid-Calf/Crew Socks

OTHER ATTIRE FOR BOYS:

SPIRIT WEAR (GRADES 6-8 ONLY)

All t-shirt and sweatshirt spirit wear related to Perimeter School and Perimeter Church may be worn <u>only on Fridays</u> (may be worn any time of the year, not just in the activity's same season). The only exception for this Friday rule is for school plays, when cast and crew members may wear their t-shirts on performance days.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The spirit of our dress code is to remain in effect for various special events throughout the year, including the Middle School Hoedown, sports award ceremonies, graduation events, eighth grade picture day, etc.

DRESS DOWN ATTIRE

Students may wear t-shirts with appropriate words/graphics, shorts, and jeans (must have a long shirt that covers the backside if they are tight). Students may not wear pajamas, leggings, tight sweatpants, short shorts, low-cut/fitted shirts, or ripped jeans.

EVERYDAY ATTIRE FOR GIRLS:

SHIRTS

• Lands' End Polo with School Logo

- Colors: classic navy*, white, or gray heather
 - Short or long sleeve (including feminine fit options)
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
- A solid white long sleeve t-shirt or turtleneck may be worn under short sleeve uniform polos.

*Every student must have a navy polo for when Casual Enrichment Attire is required. All shirttails must be long enough to remain tucked in when reaching up or bending over. No tight or undersized shirts. No oversized shirts.

PANTS AND SHORTS

- Classic or Traditional Style Pants and/or Shorts
 - Colors: navy or khaki

As long as guidelines are followed, uniform style pants and shorts may be purchased from any vendor/store. No low-rise pants. Must have belt loops for the required belt. (Grades K-2 only may have an elastic waist with no belt loops and no belt.) Not permitted: spandex, denim, corduroy, decorations, cargo pants, extra pockets, zip-off knees, or zip pockets.

SKIRTS/SKORTS/JUMPERS/KNIT DRESSES

- Lands' End Box Pleat Skirt
 - Color: classic navy/charcoal plaid (grades 3-8 only)
 - "Top of Knee" length
 - Refer to Lands' End item numbers
 - Colors: navy or khaki
 - "Top of Knee" or "Below the Knee" length
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>

Lands' End Blend Chino Skort

- Colors: navy or khaki
 - "Top of Knee" length
 - Refer to Lands' End item numbers
- Lands' End Jumper (grades K-2 only)
 - Colors: classic navy/charcoal plaid, navy, or khaki
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
 - To be worn with short or long sleeve full button-up white peter pan or oxford blouse
 - Land's End Knit Dress with School Logo (grades K-2 only)
 - Color: classic navy
 - Short or long sleeve
 - Refer to Lands' End item numbers

Length for shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, and dresses: no more than 4 inches above the middle of the back of the knee. Bike shorts in solid navy, white, or black are required with skirts, jumpers, and dresses for modesty, unless tights or leggings are worn.

BELT

Solid Color Leather or Stretch Belt

• Colors: navy, white, gray, brown, or black

Belts must not have excessive metal.

SHOES

- Tennis/Athletic (any color)
- T-strap/Mary Jane Type Sneakers
- Docksiders
- Oxfords (tie type)
- Loafers
- Flats
- Not Permitted: boots, booties, clogs, sandals, backless shoes, or heels higher than one inch

SOCKS/TIGHTS/LEGGINGS

- Solid Color Socks
 - Colors: navy, white, gray, or black
 - Small logos acceptable
 - Must not exceed knee length
 - Solid Color Tights/Leggings (under skirts/skorts/jumpers/dresses)
 - \circ \qquad Colors: navy, white, gray, or black

Socks or tights must be worn.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- P.E. Shirts and Shorts
 - Purchased from the <u>school webstore</u>
 - Grade 3: P.E. clothes will be worn to school on P.E. day.
 - \circ \qquad Grades 4-8: P.E. clothes must be worn in P.E. class only.
- Sweatpants (optional)
 - Colors: navy or gray (no writing, stripes, or designs except school logo)
 - May be worn during cold weather
 - Must be classic "baggy, loose-fitting" style (no athletic pants/yoga pants/leggings, not tight, not low-riding)
- Compression Tights (optional)
 - Colors: navy, white, gray, or black
 - May be worn under P.E. uniform

SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS/SWEATERS PERMITTED IN CLASS

- <u>SOLID NAVY</u> Perimeter Sweatshirt
 - All past and present navy sweatshirts purchased from the <u>school</u> webstore
- <u>SOLID NAVY</u> Perimeter Sweatshirt with Athletics Eagles Logo
 - Purchased from the <u>school webstore</u>
- Lands' End Navy Fleece Jacket with School Logo
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
 - Lands' End Navy Cardigan Sweater
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
 - $\circ \qquad \text{No school logo required on sweaters} \\$

Other coats and jackets may <u>only</u> be worn outside. **Pullover sweatshirts (that are** not approved Perimeter sweatshirts) may <u>not</u> be worn anywhere on campus during the school day, including carline, recess, etc.

CASUAL ENRICHMENT ATTIRE (SERVICE PROJECTS) FOR GIRLS:

Lands' End Navy Polo with School Logo

- $\circ \qquad \text{Short or long sleeve}$
- <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
- Khaki Pants, Shorts, Skirts, or Skorts
 - o Jeans may only be worn if specified by the lead service project parent for outside or messy work.
 - Casual Shoes (including tennis/athletic shoes)
 - o Boots may only be worn if specified by the lead service project parent for outside or messy work.

Students may wear sweatshirts/jackets/sweaters permitted in class along with other coats and jackets. Pullover sweatshirts (that are not approved Perimeter

sweatshirts) may <u>not</u> be worn on Perimeter School service projects, field trips, etc.

- Classic Navy/Charcoal Plaid Box Pleat Skirt (grades 3-8)
 - <u>Refer to Lands' End item numbers</u>
- Dress Shoes
 - \circ \qquad Color: navy, brown, or black
 - $\circ \qquad \text{Leather or leather-type dress shoes}$
 - Docksiders
 - Oxfords (tie type)
 - Loafers
 - Flats
 - No athletic shoes, slip-on sneakers, or boots of any kind

OTHER ATTIRE FOR GIRLS:

SPIRIT WEAR (GRADES 6-8 ONLY)

All t-shirt and sweatshirt spirit wear related to Perimeter School, Perimeter Church, and Perimeter Ballet may be worn <u>only on Fridays</u> (may be worn any time of the year, not just in the activity's same season). The only exception for this Friday rule is for school plays, when cast and crew members may wear their t-shirts on performance days.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The spirit of our dress code is to remain in effect for various special events throughout the year, including the Father Daughter Dance, the Middle School Hoedown, sports award ceremonies, graduation events, eighth grade picture day, etc. Dresses should be modest; skirts, dresses, or shorts must be no more than 4 inches above the middle of the back of the knee. Dresses may not be strapless or tight-fitting. If the dress has spaghetti straps, shoulders must be covered with a sweater or wrap. No bare shoulders or backs.

DRESS DOWN ATTIRE

Students may wear t-shirts with appropriate words/graphics, shorts, and jeans (must have a long shirt that covers the backside if they are tight). Students may not wear pajamas, yoga pants, leggings, tight sweatpants, short shorts, low-cut/fitted shirts, or ripped jeans.
