

Accommodations for Honors Living Books Reading Program

We have established an accommodation for students who struggle with reading so that they can enjoy Living Books and participate in the Honors Living Books Reading Program. If your student participates in a remedial or therapy program related to reading, they may read living books from one grade below their current grade level and still participate in the Honors Living Books Program. However, they must meet the following requirements before they are considered:

- 1. A parent must initiate the request for this accommodation by obtaining a form and securing all required signatures.
- 2. The student must be in a remedial or therapy program, and Kay Lee must sign off on it.
- 3. The principal, librarian, and parent signatures are required for completion of form.

For example, a third-grade student in therapy for reading may read and adhere to the second-grade Honors Reading List and receive recognition at the end of the year. However, we must have a signed form on hand before the list is turned in for it to count.
