

Rising Fifth Grade Summer Reading Assignment

All students are to read *The Last Battle* by C. S. Lewis. Upon completion of the book, students should select <u>one</u> of the following activities to complete.

Activities relating to *The Last Battle*:

- Create a diorama depicting your favorite part of the book. Be sure to explain your choice by writing an explanation for the viewer.
- Use your creativity to compare *The Last Battle* to the book of *Revelation* in the Bible.
- Consider the entire *Chronicles of Narnia* and write a paper to explain the meaning of the title, *The Last Battle*.
- Make a time line of all the events in the book, *The Last Battle*. This should be a colorful project which includes drawings.

Additionally, students should choose <u>one</u> of the following books to read:

- *A Long Walk to Water* by Linda Sue Park
- Banner in the Sky by James Ramsey Ullman
- Tuck Everlasting by Natalie Babbitt
- Mr. Popper's Penguins by Richard and Florence Atwater
- *Gentle Ben* by Walt Morey
- Dipper of Copper Creek by John and Jean George
- any L. M. Montgomery book not yet read

After reading their book of choice, students are to make a bookmark for the book, drawing a character on the front and writing 3-5 sentences about their favorite part of the book on the back <u>after</u> listing the title and the author.

Teachers will advise the students when these activities are due during the first week of school.
