

Second Grade Small Groups

We will be offering second grade Orton Gillingham/language support in small groups **during** the school day. We believe that the combination of the rich Perimeter School curriculum with research-based best practices will offer the most powerful opportunity for growth in the area of literacy (reading, writing, and language).

Students in this program will be a part of a second grade homeroom and will participate in most regular classroom activities (including enrichment days, service projects, Bible, and math). During the literacy block of the daily schedule (60 minutes), groups of 2-3 students will be taught by highly trained Orton Gillingham literary specialists. In addition, a speech pathologist will be a part of a weekly session to support receptive/expressive language and written expression.

Specialists will work closely with the classroom teacher. Students will receive pre and post assessments, goal setting, weekly progress monitoring, and regular parent updates.

Students participating in this program are not required to have a dyslexia diagnosis; however, and educational psychological evaluation is highly encouraged and gives Perimeter School educators a clear roadmap to best serve your child.

The cost of this program is \$3,900 and will be added to tuition.
